Behind **fragFINN** is an extensive list of Internet websites that are both interesting and safe for children. Before a website is added to this “whitelist”, a team of media pedagogues checks it against a set of strict criteria, ensuring that children have access only to websites suitable for them.

As a “smaller version” of the Internet, **fragFINN** offers children content that is entertaining, exciting, fun, informative – and above all age-appropriate. But the safe surfing area is big enough to offer something for every child. In this way, **fragFINN** helps children pursue their interests over the full length and breadth of the Internet and learn how to use the medium responsibly and on their own.

With the great number and variety of websites available through **fragFINN**, children won't notice any limits; on the contrary, more websites are being added all the time. Everyone – children and grown-ups – is invited to send the **fragFINN** team their suggestions for further websites to add to the safe surfing area.

### Setting up fragFINN on your computer!

To keep children from straying beyond the secure sites on **fragFINN**'s list, your computer needs certain protective technology. In the area for parents and grown-ups on the **fragFINN** website, you'll find detailed information about how children can surf safely with **fragFINN**. There are different ways Internet access can be limited to the whitelisted sites. Either by using free software which can be downloaded from the **fragFINN** website.

## The fragFINN whitelist



**What kind of Internet content can be included on the whitelist?**

To be included on the whitelist, websites must fulfil strict criteria which have been defined by specialists and are regularly revised and updated (for example, content suitable for children, chat rooms supervised by a moderator). An independent team of media pedagogues draws up the list, adds to and checks it on a regular basis.



**What kind of content and topics are covered by the whitelist?**

Every child is unique, so **fragFINN** strives for diversity and a broad range of topics. At **fragFINN**, children can find content on topics ranging from A for astronomy to Z for zoo.



**fsm**  **Freiwillige Selbstkontrolle  
Multimedia-Diensteanbieter e.V.**

Multimedia service providers have established a registered association to oversee voluntary self-regulation, the Freiwillige Selbstkontrolle Multimedia-Diensteanbieter e.V. (FSM). Its primary activity is working to protect young people with regard to media, in particular by combating illegal and harmful online media content. To do so, the FSM operates a complaint service and extensive outreach programmes on responsible media use for children.

The FSM is responsible for the implementation, further development and editorial administration of the website [www.fragFINN.de](http://www.fragFINN.de). The project is funded and run by telecommunications and online media companies and industry associations.

The fragFINN website is part of the initiative "A Net for Children" launched by the Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and the Media and the Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth with the aim of bringing about lasting improvement to the Internet landscape for children in Germany.
